NUMINOUS was two wide on the turn then rallied, was in a long drive and wore down rivals on the outside and was up in the final stride. AFRICAN STORM stumbled at the start then was rushed to the lead, drew off on the turn then was all out but was caught in the final stride at the wire. BURNING THE RULES raced five wide into the turn, was in a long drive but was no menace to the top two in late stretch. CRISTATA raced four wide on the turn then made a bid to mid stretch but came up empty in late stretch. FLYING IDE was inside then shuffled back on the turn, lacked a rally in the stretch drive. BAYOU DAWG raced four wide on the turn and was no factor. OFFSEASON broke in at the start then stayed on the inside on the turn and lacked a rally in the stretch. FOREIGN EXCHANGE was unhurried early and was no threat. ZE QUEST was through early and stopped.
