LIVELY DROP set a well rated pace from the start, drew off on the turn then was in a long hard drive to hold sway in the end. POOCHIEWOOCHIE was allowed to settle then started a run on the turn, moved out to be four wide in upper stretch and closed fast on the outside but was too late. KOOKOOROTCHA chased the pace while racing three wide on the turn, made a strong bid in mid stretch to range up in contention but failed to sustained that bid in late stretch. JAMI BABY was allowed to settle then swung out to be five wide in upper stretch and closed willingly in late stretch. HEY POSSUM was stalking the pace while racing on the inside, saved ground on the turn then made a bid to mid stretch but came up empty in the end. GALLANTLY raced on the inside on the turn and failed to menace. WANDA threw her head soon after the start and dropped back, was settled and moved out to four wide for the stretch drive but was no factor. ZYDECO DIVA chased the early pace while racing three wide on the turn, was used up then stopped in upper stretch and was being eased up in late stretch.
