GLOBAL PICTURES allowed to settle, circled foes around the second turn, closed determinedly and got up. ANTE PRADO never far back, was steered out before the final sixteenth and was too late. SHADOW PUNCH vied for the lead, got clear in upper stretch and then weakened late. SCAR BABY raced wide. PENBOBEN out footed early, advanced between foes down the backstretch, then showed late interest. SOLDIER'S HOPE well back early, made a four wide middle move, gained the edge nearing the drive, then flattened out. CATCH ME DADDY was outrun. OSCEOLA KISS was no real threat. DIRTY ROTTEN TRICK set the pace to the second turn, got headed and then weakened. CHAMP ABAJO inside to the drive, eased out and then faded. CHERNOFF saved ground to no avail.
