SEA THE SOLDIER was nicely rated for the start while inside, vied for the led form the inside heading into the far turn then was roused in upper stretch, dug in gamely and proved best in the end. EVEN STEVEN stalked the early pace while racing three wide then moved up and vied for the lead three wide on the far turn, dug in gamely and put a head in front in upper stretch but was unable to match strides with the winner in late stretch. EMBRASSER was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn, swung out to be five wide in upper stretch but was no menace in late stretch. HENNY'S HOPE was allowed to settle in the early going, rallied along the inside in the stretch but was no threat. ALLIGATOR BAYOU stalked the early pace then moved up four wide to vie for the lead, was four wide on the far turn then gave way in the stretch drive. WHALEOFARIDE was unhurried early then rallied along the inside in the stretch but was no factor. DAVY'S PRODUCTION stalked the early pace while racing two wide then moved up heading into the far turn to vie for the lead, was two wide on the far turn then gave way in upper stretch. SCATINEASYCAT was unhurried early and was no factor.
