Footnotes

I'M IN TO SCORE dueled from the inside early, gained a clear margin entering the turn, widen the effort at the eighth pole and was well clear while kept to task. WHISTLING BRAHMS chased the early pace from the outside, made a bid entering the turn but could not reach the winner. ALWAYS IN TROUBLE stalked the early pace from the outside, made a bid entering the drive but could only gain the show. STORMY YA WHO pressed the early pace from the outside, made a bid entering the drive and closed well late. JUNEBERRI'S SECRET outrun early, advanced inside entering the turn, responded and had good energy late. MISS BABY CAT could only improve position. COME AROUND GIRL was no real factor. WHITE TAIL CAT dueled from the outside and tired. LITTLE RED ASHE chased the early pace and tired. TAMMY G was no threat. LITTLE BIT BLUE was never close. ACCESS POWER had a steady fade.
