### Footnotes

SOUTHERN SHOT broke sharp from the inside, quickly gained the early margin, remained clear entering the turn, widen the effort at the eighth pole and was well clear while kept to task. RIO ROSE chased the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the turn, responded when asked but was no match while clearly second best. TECHE TRIBUTARIES stalked the early pace from the outside, advanced entering the turn, responded but could only gain the show. FILLY PEPPER forced the early pace from the inside, held a forward position for the drive but had nothing left. IT'S A ECHO RUMOR was no factor. ORALEE had a steady fade. KAMARELLA was never close.
