FIND THE MAGIC duelled from the inside for the early lead, remained engaged through the turn, battled through the drive with FOXY APPEAL, put that one away deep stretch then was all out to last over a fast closing LOUISIANA LIGHT the final furlong. LOUISIANA LIGHT broke in at the start bumping with BRESY, forced that one over, recovered to chase the pace from the inside, altered outside for the drive, responded but just missed. After a Stewards'

Inquiry into the running of the race LOUISIANA LIGHT was disqualified for interference. FOXY APPEAL dueled from the outside for the early lead, battled through the turn, remained engaged with the winner through the stretch but could not match strides. HEBREA chased the early pace from the outside, made a bid entering the turn but could not sustain the effort. MARY'S DEAL pressed the early pace from the outside but had nothing left. MISS SULU could only pass tired ones. HOTTIE'S DEELITE could only improve position. STORMIN ON TOP forced the early pace from the inside and tired. A RUNNIN DREAM broke in at the start and was no factor. XSTREAM HEART was no threat. FAVORITE DAUGHTER had little interest. PETT'S HONOR had a steady fade. MISS PORT BARRE showed little. BREESY was bumped hard at the start when LOUISIANA LIGHT broke in, was forced into the rail, lost rider and was vanned off.
