JUST STALLING stalked the pace while racing two wide on the backstretch, rallied three wide in upper stretch and was in a strong drive, powered to the front inside the furlong marker then drew away and held sway in the end. TOOLIGHT'S NEPHEW was allowed to settled then rallied in upper stretch, was four wide for the stretch drive, was gaining ground and finished well but was second best in the end. SALTYS TOWN dueled for the lead while two wide, was in a long drive while being hard used then weakened in the stretch drive. KING CHARGER was unhurried early then rallied and swung out to be five wide, was gaining ground but was no menace in the end. DREAM TRIAL dueled for the lead while inside on the turn, was in a long drive then weakened in late stretch. CAJUN SKY was inside heading into the turn, moved out to be six wide coming out of the turn then was no menace in the stretch. JORDON BE FAST was unhurried early and was no factor. FORTY COURTNEYS was two wide on the backstretch then failed to menace in the stretch. ALL STAR COLTON chased the early pace while inside on the turn, moved out to be three wide in the stretch and gave way.
