ST. ARIAN was chasing the early pace while racing on the inside, saved ground on the far turn and waited for an opening, slipped through the inside in upper stretch and skimmed the fence, dug in gamely in deep stretch to proved best in the end. EXPRESSIANO was settled in the early going, started a run on the far turn while four wide, gained command in mid stretch and dug in gamely but was outfinished in the end. TEXAS CITIZEN dueled for the lead while inside, was well handled then was in a long sustained drive in the stretch but weakened in deep stretch. TRUE PRIDE dueled for the lead while two wide on the backstretch, was well handled on the far turn but gave way in the stretch drive. CUDA LEE was unhurried early but failed to menace in the stretch. WATCH MY SMOKE was unhurried early then raced three wide on the far turn but was no threat in the stretch. MIRACLE CREEK was unhurried early and kept to the inside, was inside on the far turn but was no factor. ELI'S GOLD stalked the early pace while racing three wide on the backstretch, made a bid on the far turn then gave way.
