MOLLYS MISSB'HAVIN set the pace from the start, drew off on the turn and led throughout then was being kept to task in the stretch drive. CURLEY'S ISSUE chased the early pace while racing three wide on the turn, made a bid on the turn but was no match for the winner while being clearly second best. WISH ON A WIN chased the pace while two wide, was used up and weakened in the stretch. FORTUNE LEAP was settled in the early going, raced two wide on the turn then moved to the inside for the stretch drive but was no threat. APPLE INDY was unhurried early then made a late gain but was no menace. BRICK GATE raced three wide on the turn then failed to menace. KING HALL raced inside in the early going, was used up then stopped. EDNA'S GAL was outrun. PATTYCHIEF showed little.
