C C'S MANNA vied for the lead while three wide into the turn, drew off in upper stretch then was kept to a drive in the end. PRINCE CHAMPAGNE was unhurried early then rallied on the turn while four wide, was gaining ground on the outside and was up for the place in the end. ALASKAN CAUSEWAY vied for the lead while inside, was in a long drive then weakened in late stretch. OFFICER JOHN rallied on the turn while three wide then made a bid but came up empty in late stretch. ROYAL LETTERS raced four wide on the turn and was no factor. KING DAYJUR was unhurried early then moved out to be six wide and was no threat. MIKE JUNIOR vied for the early lead while between rivals, was used up then gave way on the turn. GIACO was outrun and was eased up in late stretch. SHREVEPORT ROYALE bore out on the turn and was pulled up by the rider and was walked off. WORLD FAMOUS was pulled up by the rider on the backstretch and was van off.
