FORTY MORE WINS was allowed to settled then rallied three wide on the turn, was in a strong drive and proved best in the end. MR. ANDREW was unhurried early then rallied five wide in upper stretch and closed willingly in the end but was too late. BOUCHERIE was inside and saving ground on the turn, was inside in the stretch and gaining ground but was no menace in the end. DOMINICANO was allowed to settled then moved out and was four wide for the stretch drive and gaining ground willingly in the end. LORD AUBREY dueled for the early lead then drew off into the turn, opened up a clear lead then weakened in late stretch. MIKE AND ME was five wide on the turn and failed to menace. SOVEREIGN DAY was unhurried early on and passed tiring rivals

in the stretch. BUONICONTI was inside and saving ground on the turn and was no menace in the stretch. JUSTN MIKEYS MAGIC was settled then made a three wide middle moved on the turn and faltered. RAIL'S GENUINE BOY chased the early pace while two wide, was hard used then gave way. QUICK TEMPERED was inside and steadied off heels nearing he quarter pole and was no threat. FULL VICTORY dueled for the early lead while three wide, was used up and stopped badly. DRAW BACK broke in a tangle and trailed throughout.
