ANCHORED BACK well placed from the inside, inched closer entering the second turn, responded to gain a clear margin at the eighth pole and was clear late while kept to task. BAYOU VERMILION pressed the early pace from the outside, made a bid entering the second turn, gained a short margin entering the drive but could not match strides. LUNA PEGASUS unhurried early from the outside, advanced entering the second turn, responded and was gaining late. ROLL OF THE DICE allowed to settle early, advanced outside, made a bid entering the drive but could not sustain the effort. REGAL ROSSINI forced the early pace from the outside but had nothing left. ARC LIGHT NORTH was no factor. HE BE WILD was no threat. STRIKING PRINCE was never close. WOOTSIE WHO broke sharp from the inside, set the early pace and gave way.
