CLICKETY CLEVE was settled in the early going then started a run heading into the far turn while five wide, rallied strongly and was in a strong drive in the stretch, lugged in mid stretch causing interference then drew clear in late stretch. SOUTH WEST TARGET dueled for the lead while two wide in the early going, was inside on the far turn while still in a duel, was headed in upper stretch and dug in gamely in the stretch but tired in late stretch. LUCKY BAD BOY was allowed to settle while inside in the early going, started a run then was blocked behind rivals heading into the far turn and forced to steady, started another rallied and was inside in upper stretch, angled out to be three wide in mid stretch then was forced inside in mid stretch and caused crowding then hung in he end. CAJUN IN SEATTLE was unhurried early then rallied three wide on the far turn, was in tight quarters and forced to steady sharply in mid stretch then lacked a closing bid. MY FRIEND TAG dueled for the lead while two wide on the backstretch and far turn, dug in gamely and then weakened then was bothered in late stretch and forced inside. LAURENT DU VAR was unhurried early then made a mild rally while five wide in the stretch but was no threat. BLANCO STANCO was inside and saved ground, started a run then was steadied off heels heading into the far turn and failed to respond in the stretch. EASY DANCER was unhurried early then made a strong four wide middle move nearing the top of the stretch and flattened out in the drive. ROB

HOW was allowed to settle then failed to menace. ALMOST LUCKY was outrun. MAKIN' RAIN dueled for the early lead while inside then stopped badly heading into the far turn. E Z VIEW was through after a half while racing two wide and stopped and was being eased up in late stretch. A steward's inquiry was held concerning the stretch run. After reviewing the films, the stewards disqualified CLICKETY CLEVE from first and placed him fifth for interference in mid stretch
