GOWDEN MILE far back early, advanced outside up the backstretch, responded entering the drive to duel through the drive and was just up the final strides. MAX THE KNIFE stalked the early pace from the inside, crept closer entering the second turn, responded to duel through the drive but was outfinished. LOTTO CAT pressed the early pace from the outside, made a bid entering the second turn, dueled through the drive but was outfinished. BADGER BARRY up close early from the outside, made a bid entering the second turn but had nothing left. SWEET DIXIELAND was no factor. JUST LUCK broke sharp from the outside, gained a clear early margin, remained clear entering the second turn then tired in the drive. FIRST COMMAND was no factor. QUAZAR had a steady fade. DANCING VALID showed little.
