MICHELLE'S KRACKIN was unhurried early then rallied along the inside on the far turn, swung out to be four wide in upper stretch then was in a strong drive and drew away in the end. MOTOROLA JADE stalked the pace while inside then rallied to take command on the far turn, drew off in upper stretch but could not sustain that bid in late stretch. PANCHO PUDDLES was unhurried early then was inside on the backstretch and far turn, rallied and was gaining ground along the rail and finished well in the end. HUFFS DIVY set the early pace then drew off on the turn down the backstretch, was in a long drive but weakened in the mid stretch. TIFFANY BLUE was evenly then failed to menace in the stretch. GOOD FIVE was unhurried early and failed to respond. PEYTON'S KISS was well placed while racing three wide on the backstretch, was used up and gave way on the far turn. HONORARY GALLOP chased the early pace, was used up and stopped.
