COURTESY CAT stalked the early going from the outside, inched closer entering the turn, gained the advantage at the eighth pole and was clear late while kept to task. SLEEK EZEKE dueled from between foes for the early lead, remained engaged through the turn, held a forward position entering the drive but could not keep pace. PAPA TOUGH broke slow, advanced outside entering the turn, dropped to the rail entering the drive and closed with a rush. CHANCE IDE TAKE dueled from the outside for the early lead, battled through the turn but tired in the drive. GRAND FACT dueled from the inside and tired. DA BROWN was steadied entering the turn when BELLE'S INTEREST blew the turn then went evenly late. CALL ME STONE was no factor. MOE D was never close. JURY BOUND showed little. BELLE'S INTEREST blew the turn and was eased.
