TOP CAT BOOGIE fractious during the post parade, broke well from the outside, dueled through the turn, remained engaged entering the drive, fought through the stretch and outfinished rivals the final yards. MASCULINO stalked the early pace from the outside, crept closer entering the turn, responded to duel through the drive but was outfinished. BROADWAY KING broke sharp from the inside, gained a clear early margin, dueled through the turn, remained engaged through the drive but could not keep pace. STARTEX well placed from the inside, remained forward through the drive but had nothing left. NIKKI'S PATH went evenly. SAINT MARDI GRAS could only improve position. VOODOO VODKA could only pass tired ones. BARON CROWN was no factor. GREY STREAM was no threat. BANKING WOES ran off just prior to loading, forced the early pace and steadily faded. UNO ECLIPSE showed little.
