RAILING CIGAR duled from the inside for the early lead, battled through the turn, remained in a fight through the drive and inched clear late. RIKKI DEE stalked the early pace from the outside, crept closer entering the turn, responded but could not reach the winner. INDIGO WHO duled from the outside for the early lead, battled through the turn, held a forward position entering the drive but could not keep pace. ZIP ZEE forced the early pace from the inside but had nothing left for the drive. GO AHEAD MAE was no factor. WASHINGTON PUCK had a steady fade.
