GET IN DA HOUSE was unhurried early then rallied heading into the turn, moved out to be four wide in upper stretch, was in a strong drive on the outside and powered to the front in late stretch to prove best in the end. TOUGH BRUSH was settled in the early going then rallied three wide on the turn, was in a strong drive in the stretch and finished well to be second best. TORO BRAVO chased the early pace while two wide then moved up and dueled for the lead on the turn, was in a long sustained drive then bore out in mid stretch then came up empty in the end. POPULIST POLITICS was inside in the early going then rallied and moved out to be three wide for the stretch, was in tight quarters and forced to steadied in mid stretch then came again but was no menace in the end. COTILE LAKE set the early pace then dueled for the lead from the inside on the turn, was in a long drive then gave way in late stretch. ONE PRETTY PENNY was three wide on the backstretch then was shuffled back on the turn but was no threat in the stretch. FORT HOOD was inside and saving ground on the turn then was no threat in the stretch. MANDIMAX was far back in the early going then finished with a late rally but was no threat. BEANEVELENT FUN was through after a half then stopped.
