DANCE CALLER set a well handled pace from the start, drew off in upper stretch then was confidently ridden out in the end. CHIEF JAY stalked the early pace while racing three wide on the turn, rallied strongly in upper stretch making a bid but was no match for the winner in late stretch. SWEETSOUTHERNMOON was hustled along to be four wide into the turn, made a strong bid in the stretch but was no menace in late stretch. IDE LIKE A DOUBLE was unhurried early and raced two wide on the turn, moved out to be three wide for the stretch but was no threat. BREAK UP saved ground on the turn then made a bid but came up empty in the stretch drive. CLASSY DEELITES was inside on the turn and in the stretch but failed to menace in the end. MR. PORTER was four wide on the turn and no threat. STAR PRODUCTION chased the early pace while racing two wide, was used up and gave way.
