### Footnotes

TEPIN SALSA was stalking the early pace while racing on the inside down the backstretch, rallied two wide on the far turn then was in a long sustained drive in he stretch and prevailed in the final stride. ATTRACTIVE RIDE set a well handled pace from the start, drew off on the far turn then was in a long drive but was caught at the wire. WHYWHY CAT was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn while four wide, was gaining ground in late stretch to finished well. K C SHUFFLE stalked the early pace while racing three wide, made a bid on the far turn to upper stretch then flattened out in the drive. SUSHI JOE was allowed to settled then made a three wide on the far turn to upper stretch and flattened out in the drive. PRAY TELL was unhurried early then raced on the inside on the far turn, moved out to be four wide in upper stretch and failed to menace in late stretch. RUCKUS was allowed to settled then raced two wide on the far turn but was no factor. SILVER INDY chased the early pace while racing two wide, was used up then stopped in the stretch drive.
