GENUINE SPARK was settled in the early going then rallied three wide on the turn, moved up to gain command in upper stretch then drew off in late stretch. RED HOT HALO dueled for the lead from the inside, was in a long drive on the far turn and stretch, dug in gamely in late stretch and held the place safe in the end. ERNEST DREAM was inside and saving ground on the turn, was blocked while racing on the inside and clipped heels of A GOOD DAY TO FLY, recovered and rallied then swung out to be three wide in mid stretch and was gaining ground in late stretch. A GOOD DAY TO FLY was settled while inside, saved ground on the far turn then had his heels clipped by ERNEST DREAM, bid two wide in the stretch then hung in late stretch. GIFTFOGIT was settled then rallied two wide on the far turn, swung out to be five wide in upper stretch but was no threat in the end. H AND F'S PROSPECT was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn while three wide making a bid then flattened out in the stretch drive. SHIRLEY'S PRIDE was unhurried early while racing well off the rail, was five wide on the far turn and was no factor in the stretch. ORDINARY NEWMAN was four wide on the first turn then was settled, was

three wide on the far turn then was no factor in the stretch. SNATCHER was allowed to settled while racing on the inside, was steadied off heels heading into the far turn and dropped back and lacked a late rally. AFTERNOON DEPUTY was rushed to the lead while three wide and dueled on the backstretch, was hard used then gave way on the far turn. RICKY BOBBY trailed throughout.
