RUNAWAY SATAN was bumped at the start then was settled, rallied on the far turn while three wide, stayed three wide in the stretch and was in a strong drive and proved best in the end. KODA KING stalked the pace while two wide, rallied on the far turn and gained command, drew off between calls then was in a strong drive in the stretch but was unable to hold the winner safe in the end. BIGBANDIT broke in and bumped at the start then was settled, made a mild rally on the far turn but failed to menace in the stretch drive. PIRATE MYSTERY broke out at the start and caused crowding then was sent to the front to set the pace, was in a long drive but weakened in the drive. GEAX CAT GEAX was unhurried early then was no threat. BRANDONSBABYBLAYRE was in tight and pinched back soon after the start then showed little. GENO was forced out soon after the start and bumped then failed to respond when needed.
