LIME ME was in tight quarters on the first turn and coming out of the first turn heading down the backstretch, was taken back then settled, rallied on the far turn and moved out to be out four wide and powered to the front in late stretch to be best in the end. ANASHEED CLASS was unhurried early then started a run into the far turn, swung out to be six wide in upper stretch, was in a strong drive and was gaining ground to finished well in the end. KENSETH was allowed to settled while racing two wide on the backstretch, rallied on the far turn, moved out to be four wide for the stretch drive, was gaining ground in late stretch and finished well. POW POW dueled for the lead while inside, was in a long drive then weakened in late stretch. PENTHOUSE CASANOVA dueled for the lead while two wide, was hard used then tired in late stretch. IASI was allowed to settled while racing three wide on the backstretch, rallied on the far turn then made a bid five wide in the stretch and was gaining ground in the end. BURKE'S BOOK chased the pace while racing two wide, was used up then gave way. LANE CHANGER was unhurried early and was no threat. CYCLONE'S PRAYER was in tight quarters on the first turn then chased the pace from the inside on the backstretch, was used up and faltered in the stretch. PIANO RULES was unhurried early and no factor.
