KATIE KOSMOS raced off the rail early, eased in a bit before the turn, bid three wide nearing the drive, took over turning for home and proved best while kept to pressure. FRAJANA saved ground until nearing the drive, eased out and lacked the needed kick. NANCE CAN BUCK devoid speed, advanced along the rail around the turn, was angled out in the lane and closed mildly. SECOND LINING within striking distance, came up empty. BETHS GOLD dueled for the lead for a half and then gave way. PROSPECTIVE INCOME raced wide and had no rally. A LITTLE MAGIC trailed until the drive and passed beaten foes. TUNE A WIN FOR A B showed little. MI LU set a pressured pace and stopped. ROYAL BAG was always back.
