BUST AND LOOSE was settled in the early going, raced two wide into the turn then was forced to steadied off heels in the middle of the turn, angled inside then moved back out to be two wide at the top of the stretch, angled out to be three wide in mid stretch and powered to the front in late stretch then drew clear in the end. BUMP'S MAGIC CAT chased the early pace while racing two wide on the turn, rallied in upper stretch to gain a slim lead between calls then was in a hard drive to hold the place safe in the end. MORGAN THE MIGHTY was five wide on the run down the backstretch then angled inside and

saved ground on the turn, raced on the inside in the stretch to be gaining ground in late stretch and finished well. FIRST DOWN CORY was settled then rallied five wide on the turn, stayed five wide in upper stretch making a bid but came up empty in late stretch. ZUPPARDO'S ALLUSION rallied three wide on the turn making a bid to mid stretch but flattened out in the drive. MAGICAL DEELITES was unhurried early then made a mild rally while four wide in upper stretch, angled inside in mid stretch but hung in the end. LOUISIANA PUDDLES chased the early pace while racing three wide, was used up then faltered in the stretch drive. MATTRESS MACK broke slowly from the gate then swung out to be six wide in upper stretch but was no threat in the end. DIXIE LULLABY raced on the inside on the turn and was no threat. BRENNON'S HALO chased the early pace while racing two wide, was through after a half then stopped in the stretch. HOOF FULLOFDOLLARS showed brief speed while inside, was still inside on the turn then stopped in the stretch. DR. J K L broke slowly from the gate then was outrun. MIKE'S STORM showed brief foot then dropped back on the turn and stopped in the stretch.
