Footnotes

CLASSIC ELVIS dueled for the early lead while two wide then drew off in the middle of the turn, was in a hard drive to hold sway in the end. CAJUN THIEF dueled for the lead while inside, was hard used on the turn while in a long drive then held the place safe in the end. WILD REECE stumbled at the start then chased the early pace while inside on the turn, angled out in mid stretch to be four wide and was gaining ground in late stretch. BREAK IT was unhurried early then swung out to be four wide in upper stretch and made a mild rally in late stretch. MACHO REGENT raced four wide on the turn then failed to menace in the stretch drive. GREY IDE MAN was settled then swung out to be five wide in upper stretch but was no threat. FALSE START saved ground on the turn and was no menace in the stretch. WHISTLEN PROMISE was unhurried early then was six wide for the stretch drive but was no factor. FRIGID KISS broke out and bumped at the start then raced four wide on the turn and was no threat. TUFFERTHANLEATHER chased the early pace while two wide, was used up then stopped in the stretch.
