OUR SWEET AFLEET dueled for the lead from the inside, was in a long drive then drew off in mid stretch and was kept to a drive in late stretch. RIO ROSE chased the pace while three wide into the turn, rallied coming out of the turn and was gaining ground but was second best in the end. LAMANTA was bumped at the start then well placed on the backstretch and turn, saved ground then made a mild gain in the stretch. SHAWNNAPHORA broke out at the start and bumped then was unhurried early, rallied and swung out to be six wide in upper stretch and made a mild gain in late stretch. ORALEE chased the pace while racing four wide into the turn, made a bid to upper stretch but came up empty in late stretch. WEDDING SLIPPERS dueled for the lead while two wide, was hard used then weakened in the stretch drive. HYDINGINDYINOSIDY was bumped at the start then was inside on the turn and failed to menace. WISH ON A WIN broke in at the start and bumped then was unhurried early and no factor in the stretch.
