Z RATE up close early from the inside, inched closer entering the turn, altered outside for the drive, responded and steadily drew clear. THIRTY ONE ALWAYS well placed from the inside, crept closer entering the turn, responded but could not keep pace. WALK THE TANGO stalked the early pace from the inside, steadily advanced entering the turn, responded and closed well late. BROWNDENSE chased the early pace from the outside but was no real threat late. WHAT R U DOIN dueled from the outside early, gained a clear margin through the turn but tired in the drive. FOREVER WAITING could only pass tired ones. SWAMP SHAKER was no factor. L J'S IMAGE dueled from between foes and tired. PERFECTLY DAVID was never close. GIACO was always outrun.
