HEZALOTTA WANDA chased the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the turn, made a bid along the rail entering the drive, angled out for the drive and was along in time. DRIFTING WIND stalked the early pace from the outside, responded entering the turn, came eighth wide into the drive and found his best stride too late. ROYAL PRODUCTION dueled from the outside for the early lead, gained a clear margin entering the turn, held a narrow margin at the eighth pole but could not last. LORD OF THE ROSES far back early, advanced outside, responded and closed well late. MISS LEWIS forced the early pace from the inside but had nothing left for the drive. TUPELO PLAYBOY was no factor. SAINT WILL was no threat. STRETCH O'BRIEN dueled from the inside early, was steadied mid turn when in tight then faded. GEORGIA GLITTER forced the early pace and faded. WE ADORE THEODORE had a steady fade.
