THE REVEREND JAMES up close early from the outside, dueled through the turn, remained engaged through the drive, gained a short margin deep stretch then was all out to last. AWAYFROMITALL far back early, advanced outside entering the turn, responded entering the drive and closed with a rush. RUSHMORE well placed from the inside, steadily advanced entering the turn, responded and finished well. PIE'S CHOICE forced the early pace from the outside, made a bid entering the drive but faltered. WHAT'S UP POP broke sharp from between foes to gain a clear early margin, dueled through the turn then tired in the drive. PREAPPROVED forced the early pace and faded. GODS FAVORIT REBEL was no factor. WHITEVILLE was no threat. DO THE CONGA was unprepared at the start and outrun.
