AARON'S TORNADO chased the early pace from the outside, steadily advanced entering the second turn, responded when asked entering the drive, dueled through the drive and was clear late. TREY J. far back early, advanced inside entering the second turn, reached a forward position for the drive, was blocked through the stretch, angled outside mid stretch, responded and was just up for the place in a troubled trip. UNCLE R D bobbled at the start, recovered to duel for the early margin, gained a clear advantage up the backstretch, remained clear through the second turn, dueled through the drive but tired late. MAGIC RIDGE forced the early pace from the inside, dropped back up the backstretch, altered outside, responded and finished well. MR. RAMOS was no factor. DANCINGATTHESAVOY chased the early pace from the inside, remained forward through the second turn but had nothing left. COPPER POPPER was never close. LITTLE MOON LIGHT pressed the early pace outside and gave way.
