MACHO MON was bumped at the start then dueled for the early lead from the inside while being well handled, gained command coming out of the far turn and drew off in the stretch drive while being kept to task in late stretch. SMART AND SWEET was allowed to settle while racing on the inside, rallied on the far turn while still inside but was no match for the winner in late stretch while holding the place safe in the end. COLLEGE BOUND KATE was void of early speed while inside on the backstretch, saved ground on the far turn and was making a run, moved out to be four wide in mid stretch and was gaining ground but was no menace in the end. UNUSED DREAMS dueled for the lead while two wide, was in a long drive then weakened in the stretch. IT'S A STAR broke in and bumped at the start then threw her head and was taken back, racing four wide on the run down the backstretch but was no threat. LOUISA'S OWN chased the early pace while racing three wide on the backstretch, was used up then faltered on the far turn. LOOK OF SUCCESS was two wide in the early going then stopped heading into the far turn, was pulled up in mid stretch while appearing lame and was vanned off.
