WOOZY off last, eased out while out footed, came in a bit nearing the turn, split foes before the drive, angled out turning for home, rallied gamely and prevailed. PRINCESS DEELITE raced inside throughout and got up for second. MARGARITA MAN wide early, advanced between foes around the turn, came wide for the drive and made a late gain. ATTA BOY JAKE dueled for the lead and then gave way grudgingly. SUGAR BOWL DAY veered into QUIETA SAINT at the break, recovered to vie three wide early, got out footed around the turn and then lacked a finish. GREY PAPILLON vied for the lead, gained the edge nearing mid stretch and then faltered late. PALJO raced wide and was outrun. JULIE'S RED BANDIT was no real threat. SODA POP BANDIT showed little. JAMES OF ERLTON was always outrun. QUIETA SAINT bumped at the break, was always back.
