PAC NOW HONEY saved ground while unhurried, advanced inside around the second turn, angled out four wide for the drive, collared RIVERTIDE a sixteenth out and prevailed. RIVERTIDE settled early, made a quick three wide move around the second turn, took over the lead and could not contain the winner. THOUGHTS RESPECTS far back early, circled rivals six wide and hung. LITTLE DUMPLING settled early, passed beaten rivals. HELEN'S HUNGARIAN within striking distance while four wide, faded. CAJUN WORTHETTE hard pressed while setting the pace, gave way along the rail. GENUINE GIRL off last, raced three wide while close up, gained command entering the second turn and then flattened out once reaching mid stretch. DIRT DEVIL DAISEY contested the pace for a half and stopped.
