**Footnotes**

STAR GUITAR was settled while racing on the inside on the backstretch, angled out heading into the far turn to be three wide, was in a long drive and dug in gamely throughout the stretch to prove best in the end. GREY PAPILLON set the early pace while being pressured then duelled for the lead from the inside on the backstretch, was inside on the far turn then came again just past the furlong marker but hung in the end. BREAK UP was unhurried early while racing on the inside down the backstretch, saved ground on the far turn then swung out to be four wide in upper stretch and failed to make up any ground. IDE LIKE A DOUBLE stalked the early pace while two wide then moved up to duel for the lead while two wide on the far turn, gained a slim lead in the middle of the far turn but faltered in the stretch drive. CANDIANO raced four wide on the backstretch then rallied on the far turn, moved out to be six wide for the stretch drive but failed to menace in the stretch. TWILIGHT ROSS was unhurried early while racing on the inside on the backstretch, made a bid five wide in upper stretch but was no threat in the stretch. SEA THE SOLDIER stalked the early pace while racing three wide on the backstretch, was used up and gave way heading into the far turn.
