HERE'S BOB stalked the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the turn, altered outside for the drive, responded and was along in time. AL'S DREAM up close early from the inside, steadily advanced entering the turn, responded to gain a clear margin at the eighth but could not last. CHERRYZAPPER dueled from the outside for the early lead, battled through the turn, remained forward for the drive but could not keep pace. CAMELLIA GRILL chased the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the turn, responded and closed well late. MIKE JUNIOR could only pass tired ones. LAST PRESENT was no factor. RUDESILL forced the early pace inside but had nothing left. WISHY WASHY WAY dueled from the inside and tired. M D A SILENCE showed little.
