LUKETHELUKE was stalking the early pace while racing two wide then rallied three wide in upper stretch and powered to the front in late stretch then drew off. SIR SULLY vied for the lead into the turn while two wide, was in a long drive and gamely dug in but weakened in late stretch. COACH MAC vied for the lead from the inside into the turn, was in a long hard sustained drive then tired in late stretch. ANGEL'S SHOW was inside on the run down the backstretch, made a bid two wide on the turn but was no menace in the stretch. LITTLE WHISKEY raced two wide on the backstretch then raced evenly and was no threat. A PUCK TO REMEMBER was unhurried early then made a mild rally while three wide but was no threat. BAMA PARKWAY was unhurried early and no threat throughout. VICKI'S HALO vied for the lead while three wide into the turn, was used up then faltered. MILL STONERUNNER was inside early on, was used up and stopped. SENOR LUNAR was no factor. POWER VISION was unhurried early while inside and no factor. DAKOTA COMET was outrun and eased up in the stretch. S W STORMY DAY showed brief foot then stopped and was eased up in the stretch and walked across the finish line.
