LOVELY VIN set a well handled pace from the start, drew off on the far turn then was kept to a strong drive and was best in the end. KITTY BLONDE was stalking the pace while racing inside on the backstretch, rallied two wide on the far turn making a bid then was no threat to the winner in the end. CAN WE DREAM was unhurried early then rallied along the inside on the far turn, was inside for the stretch drive and was no menace to the top two. ANCHORED BACK stalked the early pace while racing two wide then was shuffled back heading into the far turn, angled out to be six wide in upper stretch and came again in late stretch. LEADPIPEINCH was allowed to settled then rallied two wide on the far turn making a bid then flattened out in the stretch. SOLDIER ON GO was inside and saving ground on the backstretch, made a mild bid in the stretch but was no threat. NERVES OF STEEL was outrun and no factor. FULL PARDON was pressing the early pace from the inside, dropped back heading into the far turn then stopped in the stretch. STEWY was outrun. HOURCHANGINGFUTURE chased the early pace while racing three wide, was used up and stopped heading into the far turn.
