SALTY JIM chased the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the turn, responded when sat down for the drive and wore down front running MUST HAVE the final furlong. MUST HAVE up close early from the outside, dueled through the turn, gained a clear margin at the eighth pole but could not last. TRAVEL OSIDY stalked the early pace from the outside, crept closer entering the turn, responded and had good energy late. THREE LEGGED far back early, advanced outside entering the drive and finished well. FIST FULL could only pass tired ones. SO PREDICTABLE went evenly. CAJUN D'ORO chased the early pace inside and tired. HAILEES GOODOLEBOY was never a factor. BROTHER MANSA MUSA was never close. NATE TATOR broke sharp from the inside, gained a clear early margin, dueled through the turn then gave way in the drive.
