**Footnotes**

PROUST broke sharp from the outside, gained a clear early margin, was engaged from the outside by KLOZER, dueled with that one through the turn, remained engaged through the drive, responded when lightly roused mid stretch and was clear late. KLOZER bumped at the start, rushed up from the outside to duel with the winner through the turn, gained a short margin at the eighth pole but could not match strides. WHISPERING CHARM chased the early pace from the outside, advanced entering the turn, responded and was gaining late. GUTSY pressed the early pace from the inside, remained forward but could only go evenly late. CHEROKEE MAN could only pass tired ones. HESA HUNK close up from the inside early, tired. BOSTON BRAWL was no factor. HARLEY RABORN broke out at the start, hit the gate, bumped a rival and was outrun.
