WHAT'S UP POP dueled from the outside early, gained a clear margin entering the turn, widen the effort at the eighth pole and was well clear while kept to task. PROMISSORY DANCE squeezed early, was far back early, circled rivals entering the turn, responded when sat down for the drive and closed with a rush. I'M NO PLUTO stalked the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the turn, responded and had good energy late. BURNINGEXPECTATION well placed from the inside early, made a bid entering the turn and finished well. BUD IS CHOICE could only improve position. THEIRBANKINGONME was no factor. CAILOTO'S BEST BOY forced the early pace from the inside and tired in the drive. CHOUDRANT forced the early pace from the outside but had nothing left. MARDI GRAS MAN was no threat. BUZZUVIUS dueled from the outside early and tired. TUFFERTHANLEATHER had a steady fade.
