WILMA'S NUMBERONE set a well handled pace from the start, drew of fin upper stretch and was kept to a drive in late stretch and was clearly much the best. BODACIOUS GIFT broke a step slow from the gate then was sent up and rallied six wide on the turn, was in a strong drive on the outside in the stretch and was second best in the end. BOUCHERIE was three wide on the turn chasing he pace, rallied in upper stretch and was gaining ground while four wide but hung in late stretch. HINTOFPERFECTION chased the pace while two wide on the turn then made a bid in the stretch while three wide but came up empty in late stretch. ELLIE'S MISSION chased the early pace while inside then was three wide in the stretch then tired in late stretch. R. C.'S REBEL WAYS was in tight quarters heading into the turn then checked up off heels, saved ground on the turn then raced evenly in the stretch drive. LAKE SIDE TIMER was unhurried early and no threat in the stretch. NIKKI'S PATH was unhurried early then no menace in the stretch drive. ROB HOW was through early while racing four wide then gave way. THUNDER BILL trailed throughout.
