STORM HALF far back early, advanced outside entering the turn, responded when sat down for the drive and was along in time. BANFITCH well placed from the inside early, altered outside, rushed up to duel for the lead, remained engaged through the turn, gained a short margin at the eighth pole but could not last. GAR stalked the early pace from the inside, crept closer entering the turn, altered outside for the drive, responded but could not sustain the effort. OVER A BARREL chased the early pace from the outside, advanced entering the turn, responded but was too late. BUDDY'S MAN could only pass tired ones. GALLOPING GAME chased the early pace from the inside but had nothing left. SOCIAL MISFIT was no factor. CRIMSON COUNT broke sharp from the outside, gained a clear early margin the tired in the drive. FREEDOM RUN duelled from the inside early and gave way.
