KOHNKE HILL ROAD stalked the early pace while racing three wide, rallied on the turn then powered up to take command then drew off in late stretch while being kept to task. TEY'S BIG BOY dueled for the lead from the inside, was in a long drive and gamely dug in throughout the stretch drive but was no match for the winner in late stretch and holding the place safe in the end. PIRATE ISLAND dueled for the lead while two wide, was in a long drive then was outfinished in late stretch for the place. GUT CHECK raced two wide on the turn then was evenly in the stretch and no threat in the end. BUTTER BROWN bobbled at the start and was settled, moved out to be three wide on the turn then made a late rally in the stretch. SAM THE SHIFTER was unhurried early then raced two wide on the turn and was no threat. TUPELO PLAYBOY was inside on the turn and saving ground then stopped in late stretch.
