VEGAS STORM out footed early, rallied mid track, finished big late and was clearly best. LONE STAR BANDIT out footed early, moved up outside GUMBOBUCKS around the turn turn bid, got clear nearing mid stretch but was no match for the winner late. TWENTYSIXPACES raced wide and got up for the show. GUMBOBUCKS sprinted quickly clear, responded when collared around the turn, got headed before mid stretch and then faltered late. SALTER improved position. MY BOY BONZO was outrun. HEART OF THE DAY trailed early and then passed beaten foes. WYN CALLER was no real threat. CAMERONS CHOICE tired. NICK'S HUSLIN MAN was never dangerous. STAFF showed early foot and then stopped.
