WHODAT SOEASY was allowed to settle in the early going, rallied along the inside on the far turn, moved out to be two wide for the stretch, dug in gamely and proved best in the end. SHANALINO was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn two wide, was gaining ground in late stretch and finished well. SASSY WANDA was bumped hard heading into the first turn by MISS DIXIE REBEL then opened up a clear lead on the run down he backstretch, was in a hard drive in the stretch but weakened in late stretch. JOHN'S QUICK ONE was unhurried early then rallied to be six wide for the stretch drive and was gaining ground but was too late. TENPINS CUTIE was allowed to settle then failed to menace. MISS DIXIE REBEL got hustled along from the gate then was bumped hard going into the first turn by SASSY WANDA then stalked the pace from the inside, was used up then faltered in the stretch. LEESTOWN DEVA was allowed to settle and lacked a rally. LANA STAR was unhurried early and no factor. ALOTACASH was outrun. SEE JANE RUN was unhurried early and no factor. IN VICTORY LAYNE was pulled up on the first turn and walked off.
