SALTY AND FAST stalked the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the turn, altered outside for the drive, responded when asked and was along in time. STORM OR TWO broke sharp from the outside, gained a clear early margin, remained clear entering the turn, dueled through the drive but was outfinished. WAITING ON HUNTER up close early from the inside, reached a striking position entering the drive, made a bid to duel through the drive but could not match strides. PART OF MY FAMILY forced the early pace from the inside, dropped back slightly entering the turn, responded and finished well. GIANT HIT went evenly. ARTIC SEA was no factor. INCONSEQUENTIAL chased the early pace from the outside but had nothing left. EVEN was no threat. JUST LUCK was never close. CYA LATER BERT trailed throughout.
