UNITAS duled from the outside for the early lead, remained engaged through the turn, battled with DANCE CALLER through the drive and outfinished that one late. DANCE CALLER duled from the inside early, battled through the turn, fought with the winner through the drive but was outfinished. CRYSTAL MOMENT stalked the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the turn, altered outside for the drive but could not reach the winner. SWEETSOUTHERNMOON pressed the early pace from the inside, made a bid entering the drive and had a mild late gain. CLASSY DEELITES forced the early pace from the outside but had nothing left for the drive. KINGSFORD DRIVE could only pass tired ones. SOUTHERN STYLE was no factor. MR. PORTER was no threat. ATTHEBUZZER had a steady fade.
